

the living creatures that swim in the ocean. He also made every kind of bird. God looked at what he had done, and it was good. Then he gave the living


creatures his blessing—he told the ocean creatures to live everywhere in the ocean and the birds to live everywhere on earth.




God said, "Now we will make humans, and they will be like us. We will let them rule the fish, the birds, and all other living creatures."
