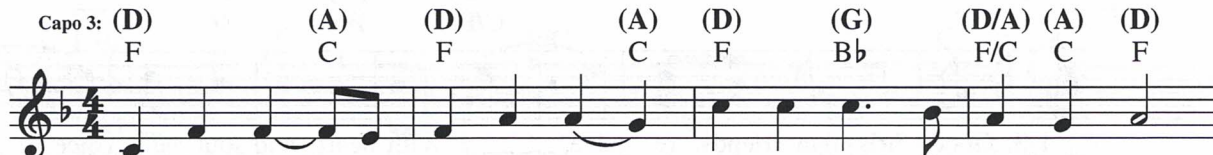

3. Light and life — to all he brings, — Ris’n with heal - ing in his wings.

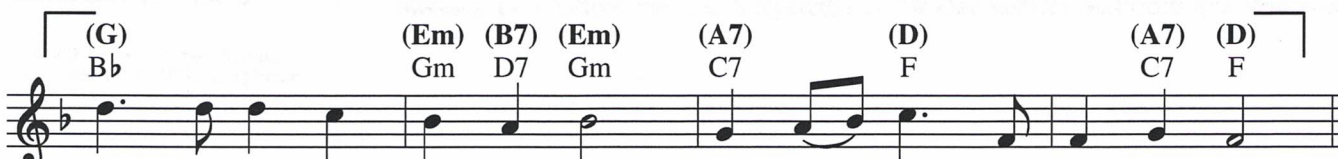


1. Joy - ful, all ye na - tions, rise, — Join the tri - umph of the skies; —
